

Neonates are much more subject to asphyxia and are far more likely to be in need of resuscitation than any other age group. The way in which an infant is managed in the first few minutes of life can have consequences of an entire lifetime. (NRP Manual, 1988).

The NRP is a national program, co-sponsored by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) and the American Heart Association (AHA) designed to teach basic neonatal resuscitation skills to those involved in the care of neonates in the delivery room. This program is taught nationally and internationally to ensure that appropriately trained health care professionals are available at every delivery to provide neonatal resuscitation if needed.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

- Identify the characteristics of primary and secondary apnea
- List the initial steps of neonatal resuscitation
- Describe the use of bag / mask ventilation equipment
- Describe the indications for intubation in the neonate
- Describe the indications for chest compressions in the neonate
- Describe the indications for use of medications in neonatal resuscitation
- Identify special situations that may complicate resuscitation and cause ongoing problems
- Discuss ethical concerns with newborn care

ACCREDITATION
